Make it attractive

Spending a little time to create the right environment for revision at home can really help children focus. If possible, try to find a place that's free from interruptions and turn off any devices that may be distracting. Make sure the space is bright and well circulated with a suitable desk and chair. Encourage them to have all their equipment at hand and to take regular breaks so they can stretch their body.



Make it visual

Mind mapping can be a great way for students to capture their ideas and revise their learning. Just start with the main idea in the middle and related ideas can radiate from there. It can help students build a visual model of a concept and help them to recall facts in an exam.

Make it obvious

- Create a revision timetable
- Display it clearly
- Put revision in the family calendar
- Set an alarm for revision time
- Stack revision onto an existing habit
