### Coronavirus Information

A coronavirus is a type of virus. As a group, coronaviruses are common across the world. Typical symptoms of coronavirus include fever and a cough that may progress to a severe pneumonia causing shortness of breath and breathing difficulties.

Based on current evidence, novel coronavirus (COVID-19) presents with flu-like symptoms including a fever, a cough, or difficulty breathing. Most cases appear to be mild and people who have died in Wuhan appear to have had pre-existing health conditions.

**If you have recently returned from China, Hong Kong, Japan, Macau, Malaysia, Republic of Korea, Singapore, Taiwan, or Thailand, you should look for any of the following symptoms:**

- cough
- difficulty in breathing
- fever (a temperature of 38 degrees C or higher)

**If you have any of these symptoms, you should:**

- if it is an emergency, call 999 and tell them which country you have returned from in the last 14 days
- if you are unwell, but it is not an emergency, call NHS 111 and tell them which country you have returned from in the last 14 days

**If you feel unwell:**

- avoid contact with others
- stay at home, do not attend work or school
- do not travel while sick
- cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when coughing or sneezing. Throw tissues in the bin

**Remember to wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.**

**Use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser if soap and water are not available.**
