

**WELCOME BACK
TO SCHOOL!**

We have enjoyed welcoming back all our children and families this week. It has been lovely seeing you all back in school.

From Monday 14th September:

Years 1 and 2 9am start to 3.20pm finish.

We are asking all the Year 1 and 2 parents to bring their children to school by **9am** and to leave them at the school gates, where staff will be on hand to direct them into their year group lines.

Please leave promptly to ensure social distancing. The children know where they are lining up from this week.

- Year 1 children in the KS1 Playground in front of the shed.
- Year 2 children at the bottom end of the Early Years playground.

This is to support social distancing by having less adults walking through the playgrounds. Please leave promptly.

Reception children 9.20am to 3.10pm

Parents can walk their child to the classroom door but please **do not** go inside. Please say goodbye and leave promptly. Your child's temperature will be taken on entering the class.

Sickness

We are doing our utmost to try and keep all the children and staff safe within the school. If your child is sick, please keep them at home. Following a parent's request, we will also be testing the children's temperatures with digital thermometers. If their temperature is high, we will phone parents to come and take their child home.



If your children are displaying any of the Corona Virus symptoms of

- High temperature
- Continuous cough
- Loss of taste or smell

Please contact your GP or NHS on 119 and ask to be tested.

PE

Children will be undertaking PE sessions in school. The class staff will let you know which days PE will be taking place. **PLEASE DO NOT BRING IN PE BAGS.** Your child will need to wear leggings or jogging bottoms with trainers or plimsolls to school on those days. They will not need to change in school.

Book bags

At the moment, **please do not bring book bags** into school. All the children will be reading in school every day but they will not be taking books home due to the Corona Virus. We will be reviewing this at half term.
