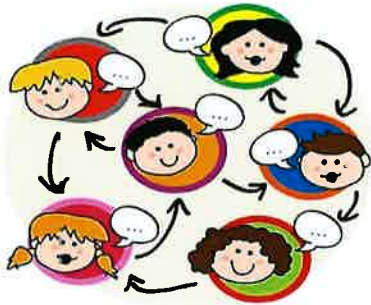


Promoting British values at Blue Gate Fields Infants
