I would like to congratulate all the children who achieved 100% attendance during the whole of the autumn term.

78 children achieved 98% - 100% attendance for the whole term— well done to the children and their families for this fantastic achievement— Congratulations!

There were 45 children who took leave within the autumn term, missing 669 sessions. No holidays will be authorised within school time. Our whole school attendance for the whole autumn term was 91.3%. We are aiming for 96%.
