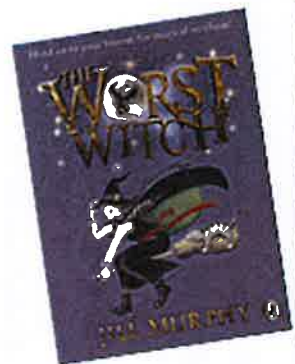


# Seas and Oceans

**OUTCOME: To have a greater understanding of the five great oceans and the surrounding seas of the UK.**
