All Saturn Reception parents welcome.

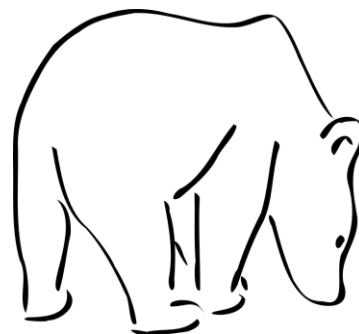
